Gleaners Food Bank of Indiana, Inc.

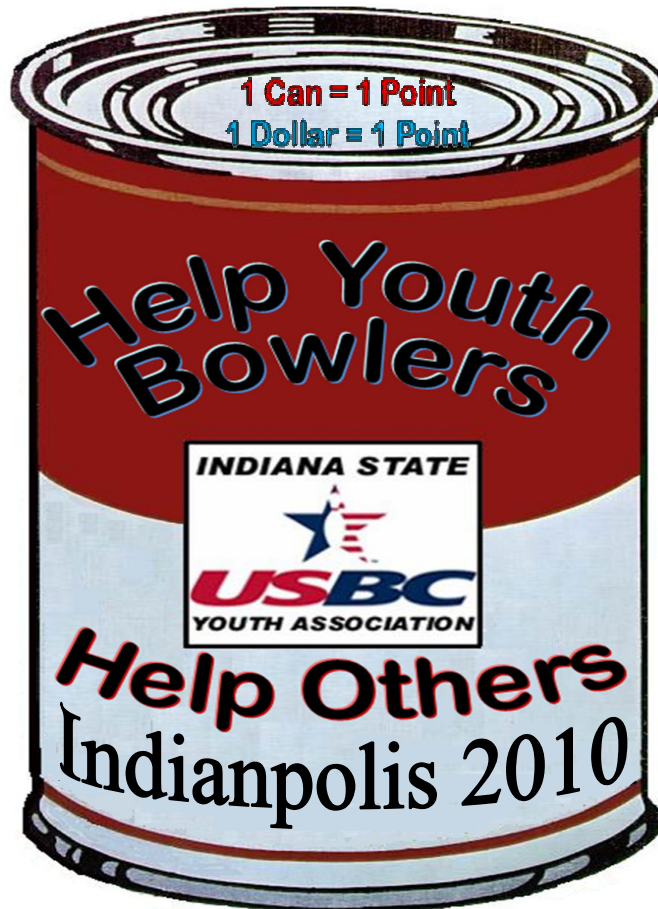
