## RULES FOR QUALIFICATION ROUNDS

1. Participant must be a certified Indiana State USBC Youth Association member.
2. Entrant must bowl in at least one event in the Indiana State Youth Championship Tournament. If not, entry fees and scores will be forfeited.
3. The walk in and second chance entries will be allowed based on lane availability.
4. **This is a SCRATCH tournament with 2 divisions Princes (Boys) and Princesses (Girls). A total of six (6) qualifying games per qualifying event.**
5. **The total actual pin fall of the six (6) games will determine the top 8 boys and top 8 girls to compete in the round robin finals in June.**
  - A. 2 Alternates from each Division may be used in Finals and should attend finals ready to bowl.
6. **Averages for boys must be 174 or less and for girls they must be 164 or less with 21 games or more at the time of participation is required in a certified Indiana USBC Youth league.**
  - A. **Entrant MUST bring an electronically generated copy of most current league standing sheet at time of entry showing their 21 game average. NO HIGH SCHOOL or TOURNAMENT AVERAGES WILL BE ALLOWED**
7. **DRESS CODE: Each participant MUST wear a collared shirt and full length DRESS slacks ONLY. All necessary undergarments must be worn AND NOT VISIBLE AT ANYTIME. Questionable attire will be decided by the Tournament Director.**
8. No advertisement of Alcohol, Tobacco or Gambling Industries will be allowed. REMEMBER this Rule will be firmly enforced and bowler violating this rule will be removed from the competition and no refund will be issued.
9. No more than eight (8) bowlers nor less than two (2) bowlers to a pair of lanes during each squad. A minimum of two (2) bowlers will be required to constitute a squad.
10. All bowling balls must conform to USBC specifications. Balls must have readable brand and model names. Any participant found using illegal equipment will be disqualified from the competition.
11. Bowlers will receive ten (10) minutes of practice before the beginning of the squad. No practice will be allowed at the start of the second 3 game block.
12. Advanced entrants MUST check in at the center no later than 30 minutes prior to the designated start time or their spot may be released if a waiting list is being used. No refund will be given; however, a later spot may be used.
13. In the event of a tie for the 8th position in qualifying, there will be a required 3 game roll off within 1 week of the end of qualifying. If a tie still exists a 9th and 10th frame roll off will be used until a decision is reached.
14. In case of center equipment failure or delay, the tournament director will make the decision regarding the continuation or re-scheduling of the game/games.
15. Bowlers should keep close check on pin fall and scoring. It is your responsibility to notify center staff or tournament staff of any errors in scoring so they may be corrected. **DO NOT CHANGE SCORES YOURSELF.**
16. Bowlers must sign score sheet prior to turning them in to tournament office. Once turned in ALL scores are final. If score sheet is not signed all scores will be forfeit.
17. Protests must be filed in person with 30 minutes of completion of qualifying event.
18. No tobacco or alcohol will be permitted in the bowlers area or consumed by a bowler during competition. Any bowlers found in violation of this rule will be removed from competition and scores disqualified.
19. No food or beverages will be allowed in the bowlers circle during competition.
20. Travel expenses, lodging, food and such may be paid for by sponsors for participants.
21. Rule 400 will apply for all bowlers who qualify for the finals.
22. Averages will be verified for all bowlers advancing to the finals and alternates.
23. **PARTICIPANTS MAY ATTEMPT TO QUALIFY A TOTAL OF TWO TIMES**
24. **ALL APPLICATIONS SUBMITTED MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY PAYMENT OR THEY WILL BE RETURNED.**
25. Any rules, scores, conduct, etc. not covered in this list will be covered by the USBC 2000-2010 Rule book and/or Tournament Director, subject to review by the ISUCBCYA Board of Directors and/or the National USBC Rules Committee.

**Finals Rules will be sent to all bowlers that advance to the Finals rounds.**

**NEW for 2010 Entrants MUST wear a collared shirt and DRESS Slacks during qualifying events see rule #7 above.**
